**In fall of 2005 the Dept. changed its course requirements.** The major change was to eliminate the subfield requirements and increase the total number of required courses for students on the general track. Regardless of when you began your studies in our program, to graduate you must meet the course requirements under the old **OR** the new policies. Courses in which you received less than a B grade cannot count in fulfilling course requirements. Languages are not counted. Introductory classes and classes fulfilling subfield requirements should be included in total of ANG graded credits.

**Department Course requirements Fall 2005:**

MA General track: 21 hrs. of ANG, at least 18 must be in letter graded lecture/seminar.  
 MA Interdisciplinary track: 12 ANG letter graded lecture/seminar (**Note:** the grad school requires at least 15 of the 30 required credits must be ANG, excluding 6971), plus 9 hours interdisciplinary hrs.  
 Ph.D. General track: 54 hrs. of ANG, at least 30 must be in letter graded lecture/seminar.  
 Ph.D. Interdisciplinary track: 36 ANG hrs. at least 30 hours must be letter graded lecture/seminar, plus 18 interdisciplinary hrs. No subfield requirements.

**Department Course requirements prior to Fall 2005:**

MA General track: 18 ANG letter graded hrs. required, 15 hrs. must be lecture/seminar.  
 MA Interdisciplinary track: Same as general track, plus 9 graduate interdisciplinary hrs.  
 PhD General track: 36 ANG letter graded hrs., 30 hrs. must be lecture/seminar classes.  
 Ph.D. Interdisciplinary track: Same as general track, plus 18 graduate interdisciplinary hrs.
